Within the United States, individual State Governments were implemented to promote the economic wellbeing, direction, and guidance of the counties and citizens that live within them. State Governments are structured in similarity to the United States Federal Government. It is at this level most bills are enacted into law and, in some cases, adopted at a federal level.

In particular, The State Government of California encompasses one of the largest collections of laws in its constitution. [Proposition 65](#), [The Air Resource Board's Toxic Control Measures](#), and the most recent [Transparency in Supply Chains Act](#) are just a few that impact our manufacturers.
